# URUGUAYAN EXPORTS OF GOODS AND SERVICES TOTALED US\$ 21,286 BILLION.

- Services exports reached US\$ 6,210 billion, representing almost 30% of total exports in 2023.
- Goods exports continue to be dominant, with a total of US\$ 12,172 billion.
- Moreover, Trading activities totaled US\$ 2,903 billion.



### **SERVICES EXPORTS**

In 2023, traditional services exports (tourism and transportation) grew for the second year in a row, exceeding figures prior to the pandemic.

**Non-traditional services** were resilient to the crisis, with a smaller drop in 2020 and a more robust recovery in 2021. Likewise, exports in 2023 were 20% above 2019 sales.


# TOURISM SECTOR BOOSTS SERVICES EXPORTS IN 2023

Services exports totaled US\$ 6,210 billion, growing by 11% in 2023.

The boost in services exports in recent years was led by a combination of global services growth (in 2021 and 2022), and the tourism recovery (in 2022 and 2023).


YEAR-ON-YEAR PERCENTAGE VARIATION







# THERE HAS BEEN A STRONG INFLUX OF TOURISTS

In 2023, 3,835,000 tourists entered the country, 55% more than in 2022. This figure is similar to the historical maximum observed in 2017. If non-resident Uruguayans are not considered, 2,971,000 foreign tourists entered in 2023, which represents an increase of 10% compared to 2019.

In 2023, tourist spending in Uruguay continued to recover, reaching US\$ 2,542 billion and exceeding pre-pandemic values.

### **ICT EXPORTS**

# In 2023, ICT exports totaled US\$ 1,218 billion.


Software and ITO services remained stable in 2023, with US\$ 1,020 billion. These services presented an expansion trend during the last years.

In 2023, the ICT sector accounted for 20% of Uruguay's services exports.

Exports of telecommunications services have remained around US\$ 200 million in the last five years.





Corporate services: considering professional and technical services, they totaled US\$ 1,330 billion in 2023, which represents a drop of 9%.

Financial services had a slight increase of 35%, exporting around US\$ 337 million in 2023.

### TRANSPORTATION AND RELATED SERVICES

Reached US\$ 534 million in 2023 (a decline of 8% compared to 2022).

# PERSONAL, CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES

Sales abroad totaled US\$ 57 million in 2023, of which US\$ 28 million were audiovisual services.

### OTHER NON-TRADITIONAL SERVICES

Totaled US\$ 84 million in exports during 2023, figure that remained unchanged in year-on-year term.

### INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Exports for US\$ 72 million in 2023 meant a drop of 5% compared to the previous year.
